Mrs. MINK of Hawaii (for herself, Mr. ABERCROMBIE, and Mr. HASTINGS of
Florida) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Com-
mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To ensure that individuals scheduled for certain flights are
not penalized for canceling or rescheduling such flights.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN FEES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Transportation
5 shall take such action as is necessary to ensure that an
6 air carrier that receives assistance under section 101(a)(2)
7 of the Air Transportation Safety and System Stabilization
8 Act (Public Law 107–42) shall—

1 (1) refund the amount paid by an individual for
2 air transportation canceled between September 11,
3 2001, and September 11, 2002; and

4 (2) not assess any fee to a passenger who can-
5 celed or rescheduled such air transportation.

6 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section the terms “air
7 carrier” and “air transportation” have the meanings such
8 terms have under section 40102 of title 49, United States
9 Code.
