A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, relating to minimum penalties for repeat offenders for driving while intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 164(a)(5) of title 23, United States Code,
4 is amended—

5 (1) by striking subparagraphs (A) and (B) in-
6 serting the following:

7 “(A) receive a driver’s license suspension
8 for not less than 1 year and be subject to—

1 “(i) the impoundment or immobiliza-
2 tion of 1 or more of the individual’s motor
3 vehicles; or

4 “(ii) the installation of an ignition
5 interlock system on 1 or more of the indi-
6 vidual’s motor vehicles for not less than 1
7 year;”; and

8 (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (C) and
9 (D) as subparagraphs (B) and (C), respectively.
