A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to ensure that acts of torture, as proscribed by the Torture Convention, are also recognized as criminal if committed in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Torture Prevention
5 and Accountability Act of 2001”.

6 **SEC. 2. TORTURE IN THE UNITED STATES.**

7 Section 2340A of title 18, United States Code, is
8 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting “or within”
2 after “outside”;

3 (2) in subsection (b)—

4 (A) by striking “or” at the end of para-
5 graph (1);

6 (B) by striking the period at the end of
7 paragraph (2) and inserting “; or” and

8 (C) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(3) the offense takes place in the United
10 States.”; and

11 (3) in subsection (a), by striking “punished by
12 death or”.

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
