A BILL

To limit the number of H1–B nonimmigrant visas issued in any fiscal year.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "High-tech Work Fair-
- 5 ness and Economic Stimulus Act of 2001".
- 6 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON H1-B NONIMMIGRANT VISAS.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b) and not-
- 8 withstanding any other provision of law, the number of
- 9 nonimmigrants who may be admitted under section
- 10 101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 11 Act shall not exceed 65,000 in any fiscal year.

- 1 (b) Reduction in Number Based on Unemploy-
- 2 MENT RATE.—The number under subsection (a) shall be
- 3 reduced by 10,000 for each quarter percentage point by
- 4 which the unemployment rate for the United States ex-
- 5 ceeds 6 percent, as reported by the Department of Com-
- 6 merce for the latest 12-month period preceding the begin-
- 7 ning of the fiscal year for which the number under sub-
- 8 section (a) is to be adjusted.
