- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans' Small Busi-
- 5 ness Relief Act of 2001".

2	OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY VETERANS
3	FROM GUARANTEE FEES.
4	Section 7(a)(18) of the Small Business Act (15
5	U.S.C. 636(a)(18)) is amended by adding at the end the
6	following new subparagraph:
7	"(C) Exemption.—In the case of loans
8	guaranteed under this subsection to a small
9	business concern owned and controlled by vet-
10	erans who were discharged or released from
11	military service not more than 5 years before
12	the date of the application for such loan, no
13	guarantee fee shall be collected by the Adminis-
14	tration or charged to the borrower.".
