A BILL

To provide for the distribution of assets frozen pursuant to Executive Order 13224 and similar Executive orders to the State of New York, the State of Pennsylvania, and the Department of Defense to cover cleanup and reconstruction costs associated with the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Cleanup and Recon-
3 struction Assistance Act of 2001”.

4 **SEC. 2. USE OF VESTED ASSETS FROZEN PURSUANT TO EX-**
5 **ECUTIVE ORDER.**

6 If and when the President vests and liquidates assets
7 frozen pursuant to Executive Order 13224 of September
8 23, 2001, or subsequent Executive orders issued as a re-
9 sult of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, the
10 assets so vested and liquidated shall be deposited in a sep-
11 arate account in the Treasury. The President shall dis-
12 tribute amounts in the account to the State of New York,
13 the State of Pennsylvania, and the Department of Defense
14 to cover costs associated with—

15 (1) the removal of debris left as a result of the
16 damage caused by the terrorist attacks on the World
17 Trade Center and the Pentagon, and the crash of
18 the hijacked airliner in Pennsylvania, on September
19 11, 2001; and

20 (2) reconstruction on the sites on which the
21 damage occurred.

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
