A BILL

To extend nondiscriminatory treatment to the products of
Afghanistan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREAT-**
4 **MENT TO THE PRODUCTS OF AFGHANISTAN.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6 sion of law, nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade re-
7 lations treatment) applies to the products of Afghanistan.

8 (b) CONFORMING TARIFF SCHEDULE AMEND-
9 MENT.—General Note 3(b) of the Harmonized Tariff
10 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking “Af-
11 ghanistan”.

1 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) and the
2 amendment made by subsection (b) apply with respect to
3 goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consump-
4 tion, on or after the 15th day after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act.
