To extend nondiscriminatory treatment to the products of Afghanistan.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREAT-
- 4 MENT TO THE PRODUCTS OF AFGHANISTAN.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 6 sion of law, nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade re-
- 7 lations treatment) applies to the products of Afghanistan.
- 8 (b) Conforming Tariff Schedule Amend-
- 9 Ment.—General Note 3(b) of the Harmonized Tariff
- 10 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking "Af-
- 11 ghanistan".

- 1 (c) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) and the
- 2 amendment made by subsection (b) apply with respect to
- 3 goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consump-
- 4 tion, on or after the 15th day after the date of the enact-

5 ment of this Act.
