A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide competitive civil service status for National Guard technicians who are involuntarily separated other than for cause from National Guard service.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPETITIVE CIVIL SERVICE STATUS FOR NA-**
4 **TIONAL GUARD TECHNICIANS WHO ARE IN-**
5 **VOLUNTARILY SEPARATED FROM NATIONAL**
6 **GUARD SERVICE.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3304(c)(2) of title 5,
8 United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) by striking “for at least 3 years” in the
2 matter preceding subparagraph (A);

3 (2) by inserting “and” at the end of subpara-
4 graph (A);

5 (3) by striking subparagraph (B); and

6 (4) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as sub-
7 paragraph (B).

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to individuals invol-
10 untarily separated from service as a technician on or after
11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
