Mr. HEFLEY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To establish certain requirements relating to the acquisition, transfer, or disposal of public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FINDINGS.**

4 The Congress finds that—

5 (1) the Bureau of Land Management presently
6 holds title to 1,800,000,000 acres of public land;
7 (2) much of this land is marginal in value and
8 left over from the 19th century;

11 (6) the transfer of some of these parcels could
12 effect budget savings and greater management effi-
13 ciencies for the Bureau

14 SEC. 2. ACQUISITION OF LANDS BY THE BUREAU OF LAND
15 MANAGEMENT.

16 (a) PROHIBITION.—Except as provided by section 3,
17 Federal funds appropriated or otherwise made available
18 after the date of the enactment of this Act may not be
19 obligated or expended for the acquisition of any lands or
20 interests therein which are to be administered by the Bu-
21 reau of Land Management.

22 (b) ACQUISITION WITH DONATED FUNDS OR PRO-
23 CEEDS FROM THE SALE OF CERTAIN LANDS OR BY EX-
24 CHANGE.—After the date of the enactment of this Act,

1 lands or interests therein may be acquired for administra-
2 tion by the Bureau of Land Management only—
3 (1) by exchange;
4 (2) by donation;
5 (3) from amounts made available from the
6 Fund pursuant to section 3; or
7 (4) if obligated to be acquired on or before the
8 date of the enactment of this Act.

9 **SEC. 3. BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT LAND SALE AND**
10 **ACQUISITION FUND.**

11 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—There is established the Bu-
12 reau of Land Management Land Sale and Acquisition
13 Fund (hereafter in this Act referred to as the “Fund”).
14 (b) **ADMINISTRATION.**—The Fund shall be adminis-
15 tered by the Secretary.

16 (c) **DEPOSITS INTO FUND.**—There shall be deposited
17 into the Fund—

18 (1) all amounts received by the Secretary from
19 the disposal of any lands or interests therein admin-
20 istered by the Bureau of Land Management; and

21 (2) all amounts received by the United States
22 by gift for acquisition of lands to be administered by
23 the Bureau of Land Management.

24 (d) **EXPENDITURES FROM FUND.**—Amounts may be
25 made available from the Fund for the acquisition of lands

1 or interests therein to be administered by the Bureau of
2 Land Management.

3 **SEC. 4. INFORMATION REQUIRED TO BE INCLUDED IN AN-**
4 **NUAL BUDGET REQUESTS RELATING TO THE**
5 **TRANSFER OR DISPOSAL OF PUBLIC LANDS.**

6 Annual budget requests submitted by the Secretary
7 shall be accompanied by information as to whether the Bu-
8 reau of Land Management, through preparation of land-
9 use plans pursuant to the Federal Land Policy and Man-
10 agement Act of 1976, has identified public lands which
11 are suitable for transfer to other management or for dis-
12 posal through exchange or otherwise, the transfer or dis-
13 posal of which have been delayed because of incomplete
14 surveys or other reasons. If enactment of additional legis-
15 lation would be desirable in order to facilitate the transfer
16 or disposal of public lands described in the request, the
17 Secretary may include a proposal for such additional legis-
18 lation in such request.
