- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—If a person invokes eminent do-
- 6 main and begins condemnation of the Fee Land, the Sec-
- 7 retary shall—
- 8 (1) immediately consider the fee into trust ap-
- 9 plication concerning the Fee Land submitted by the

2	actment of this Act; and
3	(2) by not later than 30 days after the date of
4	the beginning of the condemnation process, issue a
5	final ruling on such application.
6	(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
