## A BILL

To authorize appropriations for the Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor in Massachusetts and Rhode Island, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**3 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4       Section 10(b) of the Act entitled “An Act to establish  
5 the Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor  
6 in Massachusetts and Rhode Island” approved November  
7 10, 1986 (Public Law 99-647; 16 U.S.C. 461 note), is  
8 amended to read as follows:

1        “(b) DEMONSTRATION FUNDS.—There are author-  
2 ized to be appropriated from fiscal years 2002 through  
3 2011 not more than \$15,000,000 to carry out the provi-  
4 sions of section 8(c). Such funds shall remain available  
5 until expended.”.
