3 SECTION 1. UNIFORM MEDICARE+CHOICE PAYMENT RATES

4 FOR ALL AREAS WITHIN A METROPOLITAN
5 STATISTICAL AREA.

6 Section 1853(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
7 1395w-23(d)) is amended—

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1	(1) in paragraph (1) , by striking "paragraph
2	(3)" and inserting "paragraphs (3) and (4) ";
3	(2) in paragraph $(3)(D)$, by inserting "and in
4	paragraph (4)" after "in subparagraph (C)"; and
5	(3) by adding at the end the following new
6	paragraph:
7	"(4) Consolidated treatment of areas
8	WITHIN A METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA.—
9	"(A) IN GENERAL.—Effective beginning
10	with 2003, all the portions of each metropolitan
11	statistical area (regardless of whether they are
12	located in one or more States) shall be treated
13	as a single Medicare+Choice payment area.
14	"(B) BUDGET NEUTRALITY ADJUST-
15	MENT.—The Secretary shall beginning with
16	2003 and annually thereafter adjust the pay-
17	ment rates otherwise established under this sec-
18	tion for Medicare+Choice payment areas in a
19	manner so that the aggregate of the payments
20	under this section in the State shall not exceed
21	the aggregate payments that would have been
22	made under this section for Medicare+Choice
23	payment areas in the State in the absence of
24	the changed effected under subparagraph (A).".

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
