A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1986 to limit the non-Federal share of the cost of shore protection projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Community Beaches
5 Protection Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SHORE PROTECTION PROJECTS.**

2 Section 103 of the Water Resources Development Act
3 of 1986 (33 U.S.C. 2213) is amended by adding at the
4 end the following:

5 “(n) SHORE PROTECTION PROJECTS.—

6 “(1) PROHIBITION ON SOLICITATION OF EX-
7 CESS CONTRIBUTIONS.—The Secretary shall not so-
8 licit or accept contributions from non-Federal inter-
9 ests for costs of constructing projects or measures
10 for shore protection in excess of the non-Federal
11 share assigned to the appropriate project purposes
12 listed in subsections (a), (b), and (c).

13 “(2) FULL PAYMENT OF CERTAIN COSTS BY
14 NON-FEDERAL INTERESTS.—Paragraph (1) shall not
15 limit the authority of the Secretary to require non-
16 Federal interests to pay the full cost of work per-
17 formed outside the authorized scope of a project.”.
