3 **SECTION 1. EQUITABLE REIMBURSEMENT RATES UNDER**
4 **THE MEDICARE PROGRAM FOR THIN PREP**
5 **PAP SMEARS TESTS.**

6 The first sentence of Section 1833(h)(7) of the Social
7 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(h)(7)) is amended by in-
8 serting before the period the following: “and, in the case

1 of such a test for which a claim is billed under HCPCS
2 code 88142, \$28 for tests furnished in 2002”.
