A BILL

To amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to establish special requirements for determining whether the black-tailed prairie dog is an endangered species or threatened species.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Rancher Preservation
- 5 Act".

1	SEC. 2. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS REGARDING BLACK-
2	TAILED PRAIRIE DOG.
3	(a) In General.—Section 13 of the Endangered
4	Species Act of 1973 is amended to read as follows:
5	"SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS REGARDING BLACK-TAILED
6	PRAIRIE DOG
7	"Sec. 13. (a) Use of Best Scientific and Com-
8	MERCIAL DATA AVAILABLE.—In any case in which the
9	Secretary is required by this Act to use the best scientific
10	and commercial data available with respect to determining
11	whether the black-tailed prairie dog (Cynomys
12	ludovicianus) is an endangered species or a threatened
13	species, the Secretary—
14	"(1) in evaluating comparable data, shall give
15	greater weight to scientific or commercial data that
16	are empirical or have been field-tested or peer-re-
17	viewed; and
18	"(2) shall include, in data used with respect to
19	that species, data regarding population numbers of
20	the species.
21	"(b) Field Data.—
22	"(1) REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary may not
23	determine under section 4 that the black-tailed prai-
24	rie dog (Cynomys ludovicianus) is an endangered
25	species or a threatened species unless the determina-

1	tion is supported by data obtained by observation of
2	the species in the field.
3	"(2) Data from Landowners.—The Sec-
4	retary shall—
5	"(A) accept and acknowledge receipt of
6	data regarding the status of that species that is
7	collected by an owner of land through observa-
8	tion of the species on the land; and
9	"(B) include the data in the rulemaking
10	record compiled for any determination that the
11	species is an endangered species or a threatened
12	species.
13	"(c) Independent Scientific Review Require-
14	MENTS.—
15	"(1) Definitions.—In this subsection:
16	"(A) Action.—The term 'action' means—

1	"(B) QUALIFIED INDIVIDUAL.—The term
2	'qualified individual' means an individual with
3	expertise in the biological sciences—
4	"(i) who through publication of peer-
5	reviewed scientific literature or other
6	means, has demonstrated scientific exper-
7	tise on the black-tailed prairie dog or a
8	similar species or other scientific expertise
9	relevant to the decision of the Secretary
10	under section 4(a) or (f);
11	"(ii) who does not have, or represent
12	any person with, a conflict of interest with
13	respect to the determination that is the
14	subject of the review;
15	"(iii) who is not a participant in any
16	petition or proposed or final determination
17	before the Secretary; and
18	"(iv) who has no direct financial in-
19	terest, and is not employed by any person
20	with a direct financial interest, in opposing
21	the action under consideration.
22	"(2) List of independent scientific re-
23	VIEWERS.—The Secretary shall solicit recommenda-
24	tions from the National Academy of Sciences and
25	develop and maintain a list of qualified reviewers to

- participate in independent scientific review of actions.
- 3 "(3) Appointment of independent SCI-ENTIFIC REVIEWERS.—(A) Before any action shall 5 become final, the Secretary shall appoint randomly, 6 from among the list prepared in accordance with 7 this section, 3 qualified individuals who shall review 8 and report to the Secretary on the scientific infor-9 mation and analyses on which the proposed action is 10 based.
 - "(B) The selection and activities of the reviewers selected pursuant to this section shall not be subject to the Federal Advisory Committee Act (5 U.S.C. App.).
 - "(C) Reviewers shall be compensated for conducting the independent review.
 - "(4) Opinion of Peer Reviewers.—Independent reviewers shall provide the Secretary, within 3 months, their opinion regarding all relevant scientific information and assumptions relating to the taxonomy, population models, and supportive biological and ecological information for the black-tailed prairie dog.
- 24 "(5) Final determination.—If the referees 25 have made a recommendation on a proposed action,

1	the Secretary shall evaluate and consider the infor-
2	mation that results from the independent scientific
3	review and include in the final determination—
4	"(A) a summary of the results of the inde-
5	pendent scientific review; and
6	"(B) in a case in which the recommenda-
7	tion of a majority of the referees who conducted
8	the independent scientific review is not followed,
9	an explanation as to why the recommendation
10	was not followed.
11	"(6) Public Notice.—The report of the peer
12	reviewers shall be included in the official record of
13	the proposed action and shall be available for public
14	review prior to the close of the comment period on
15	the proposed action.".
16	(b) Conforming Amendment.—The table of sec-
17	tions in the first section of such Act is amended by strik-
18	ing the item relating to section 13 and inserting the fol-
19	lowing

"Sec. 13. Special requirements regarding black-tailed prairie dog.".
