## **AN ACT**

- To assist in the preservation of archaeological, paleontological, zoological, geological, and botanical artifacts through construction of a new facility for the University of Utah Museum of Natural History, Salt Lake City, Utah.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Utah Public Lands

5 Artifact Preservation Act".

- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 Congress finds that—

1	(1) the collection of the Utah Museum of Nat-
2	ural History in Salt Lake City, Utah, includes more
3	than 1,000,000 archaeological, paleontological, zoo-
4	logical, geological, and botanical artifacts;
5	(2) the collection of items housed by the Mu-
6	seum contains artifacts from land managed by—
7	(A) the Bureau of Land Management;
8	(B) the Bureau of Reclamation;
9	(C) the National Park Service;
10	(D) the United States Fish and Wildlife
11	Service; and
12	(E) the Forest Service;
13	(3) more than 75 percent of the Museum's col-
14	lection was recovered from federally managed public
15	land; and
16	(4) the Museum has been designated by the leg-
17	islature of the State of Utah as the State museum
18	of natural history.
19	SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.
20	In this Act:
21	(1) MUSEUM.—The term "Museum" means the
22	University of Utah Museum of Natural History in
23	Salt Lake City, Utah.
24	(2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
25	the Secretary of the Interior.

3 (a) ASSISTANCE FOR MUSEUM.—The Secretary shall
4 make a grant to the University of Utah in Salt Lake City,
5 Utah, to pay the Federal share of the costs of construction
6 of a new facility for the Museum, including the design,
7 planning, furnishing, and equipping of the Museum.

8 (b) GRANT REQUIREMENTS.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—To receive a grant under
10 subsection (b), the Museum shall submit to the Sec11 retary a proposal for the use of the grant.

12 (2) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of
13 the costs described in subsection (a) shall not exceed
14 25 percent.

15 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
16 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
17 \$15,000,000, to remain available until expended.
