- 3 SECTION 1. GRANT FOR SUPPORT OF STATE VETERANS'

- 5 The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall make a grant
- 6 in the amount of \$2,200,000 to the State of Connecticut
- 7 for alteration of an existing facility for use as a rec-
- 8 reational facility at the State veterans' home and hospital

- 1 in Rocky Hill, Connecticut. The grant shall be made from
- 2 funds appropriated to the Department of Veterans Affairs
- 3 for fiscal year 2003 for "Grants for Construction of State

4 Extended Care Facilities".
