A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to provide duty-free treatment for certain tractor parts suitable for agricultural use.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRACTOR BODY PARTS.**

4 (a) CERTAIN TRACTOR PARTS.—Heading 8708 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking subheading 8708.29.20 and in-
8 serting the following new subheadings, with the su-
9 perior heading for subheadings 8708.29.20 and

1 8708.29.25 having the same degree of indentation as
 2 the article description for subheading 8708.29.15:

“	8708.29.20	Body stampings: For tractors suitable for agri- cultural use	Free		Free	”;
	8708.29.25	Other	2.5%	Free (A, B, CA, E, IL, J, JO, MX)	25%	

3 and

4 (2) by inserting in numerical sequence the fol-
 5 lowing new subheading, with the article description
 6 for subheading 8708.29.40 having the same degree
 7 of indentation as the article description for sub-
 8 heading 8708.29.15:

“	8708.29.40	Parts with structural supports for tractors suitable for agricultural use	Free		Free	”.

9 (b) STAGED RATE REDUCTIONS.—Any staged reduc-
 10 tion of a rate of duty proclaimed by the President before
 11 the date of the enactment of this Act, that—

12 (1) would take effect on or after such date of
 13 enactment; and

14 (2) would, but for the amendment made by sub-
 15 section (a)(1), apply to subheading 8708.29.20 of
 16 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
 17 States,

18 applies to the corresponding rate of duty set forth in sub-
 19 heading 8708.29.25 of such Schedule (as added by sub-
 20 section (a)).

1 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
