A BILL

To provide for the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to the products of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS.
- 4 Congress makes the following findings:
- 5 (1) The Republic of Uzbekistan has been found
- 6 to be in full compliance with the freedom of emigra-
- 7 tion requirements under title IV of the Trade Act of
- 8 1974.

- 1 (2) Since its independence from the Soviet 2 Union in 1991, Uzbekistan has made progress to-3 ward a free-market economy system.
- 4 (3) The United States and Uzbekistan reached 5 agreement on a draft bilateral investment treaty in 6 1994 and the treaty was subsequently ratified by 7 both countries.
 - (4) Uzbekistan has the potential to play a key stabilizing and cooperative role in enhancing the independence and security of the countries of the Central Asia region.
 - (5) Engaging Uzbekistan through free and fair trade is important for fostering continued progress in democratic reforms and human rights.
 - (6) The extension of unconditional normal trade relations treatment to the products of Uzbekistan will enable the United States to avail itself of all rights under the World Trade Organization with respect to Uzbekistan.
- 20 SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV OF 21 THE TRADE ACT OF 1974 TO UZBEKISTAN.
- 22 (a) Presidential Determinations and Exten-23 sions of Nondiscriminatory Treatment.—Notwith-24 standing any provision of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974 25 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.), the President may—
