6	(a) In General.—Subsection (d) of section 502 of
7	the Veterans Education and Benefits Expansion Act of
8	2001 (Public Law 107–103; 115 Stat. 994; 38 U.S.C.
9	2306 note) is amended by striking "the date of the enact-
10	ment of this Act" and inserting "September 11, 2001".
11	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
12	subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
13	ment of such section 502.
