4	Section 12(n) of the Richard B. Russell National
5	School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1760(n)) is amended by
6	adding at the end the following:
7	"(4) Applicability to puerto rico.—Para-
8	graph (2)(A) shall apply to a school food authority
9	in Puerto Rico with respect to domestic commodities
10	or products that are produced in Puerto Rico in suf-
11	ficient quantities to meet the needs of meals pro-
12	vided under the school lunch program under this Act
13	or the school breakfast program under section 4 of
14	the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1773).".
