## A BILL

To amend the Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 and title 5, United States Code, to allow leave for individuals who provide living organ donations.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Living Organ Donor
- 5 Job Security Act of 2002".
- 6 SEC. 2. LEAVE FOR LIVING ORGAN DONATION.
