- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR
- 4 GERMALYN SELGA SALTO AND CARL GINO
- 5 SELGA SALTO.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 7 sion of law, for the purposes of the Immigration and Na-
- 8 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Germalyn Selga
- 9 Salto and Carl Gino Selga Salto shall be held and consid-
- 10 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States

- 1 for permanent residence as of the date of enactment of
- 2 this Act.
- 3 (b) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Numbers.—
- 4 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Germalyn
- 5 Selga Salto and Carl Gino Selga Salto, the Secretary of
- 6 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce the num-
- 7 ber of immigrant visas that are made available to natives
- 8 of the country of the alien's birth under section 203(a)
- 9 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 10 1153(a)) or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant
- 11 visas that are made available to natives of the country of
- 12 the alien's birth under section 202(e) of such Act (8
- 13 U.S.C. 1152(e)).
