- 4 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.28.19 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
- 6 in the effective period column by striking the date con-
- 7 tained therein and inserting "12/31/2005".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 9 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,
- 10 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

- 1 the date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment
- 2 of this Act.
