1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY. 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.85.41 of the Har-5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended— 6 7 (1) in the general rate of duty column, by striking "1%" and inserting "Free"; and 8 (2) in the effective period column, by striking 9 the date contained therein and inserting "12/31/ 10

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,
- 3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 4 the date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment
