## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain cathode-ray  
tubes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.85.41 of the Har-  
5       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended—

7               (1) in the general rate of duty column, by strik-  
8       ing “1%” and inserting “Free”; and

9               (2) in the effective period column, by striking  
10       the date contained therein and inserting “12/31/  
11       2007”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,  
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment  
5 of this Act.
