- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. COVERAGE OF COMPRESSION SLEEVES AND
- 4 STOCKINGS FOR THE TREATMENT OF
- 5 LYMPHEDEMA.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1861(s)(9) of the Social
- 7 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(9)) is amended—
- 8 (1) by inserting "(A)" after "(9)";

1	(2) by adding "and" at the end; and
2	(3) by adding at the end the following:
3	"(B) compression sleeves or stockings for the
4	treatment of lymphedema, including replacements if
5	required because of a change in the patient's phys-
6	ical condition;".
7	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
8	subsection (a) shall apply to items and services furnished
9	on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
