To suspend temporarily the duty on cases for certain
children's products.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.42.03	Cases or containers (provided for in subheading 4202.92.90) designed for transporting, storing, or protecting circular mounts for sets of stereoscopic photographic transparencies, such mounts measuring approximately 8.99 cm in diameter	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
 4 after the date of enactment of this Act.
