A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Energy to conduct a study of the effects of year-round daylight saving time on fossil fuel usage.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STUDY.**

4 The Secretary of Energy shall conduct a study of the
5 effects of year-round daylight saving time on fossil fuel
6 usage. The study shall examine the effects if the entire
7 United States were to adopt year-round daylight saving
8 time, and the effects on each major region of the country
9 separately. Not later than one year after the date of the

- 1 enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall transmit to the
- 2 Congress a report of the findings of the study.
