## A BILL

To amend titles 10 and 38, United States Code, to extend the time limitation for use of eligibility and entitlement to educational assistance under the Montgomery GI Bill.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Military Education Ex-
- 5 tension Act of 2002".

#### 1 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TIME LIMITATION FOR USE OF ELI-

- 2 GIBILITY AND ENTITLEMENT.
- 3 (a) All Volunteer Force Program.—Section
- 4 3031 of title 38, United States Code, is amended—
- 5 (1) by striking "10-year period" each place it
- 6 appears (other than subsection (g)) and inserting
- 7 "15-year period"; and
- 8 (2) in subsection (g), by striking "the last day"
- 9 and all that follows through "Act" and inserting
- "November 30, 2014,".
- 11 (b) Educational Assistance for Selected Re-
- 12 SERVE.—Section 16133(a) of title 10, United States Code,
- 13 is amended by striking "10-year period" and inserting
- 14 "15-year period".
- (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 16 this section shall take effect on the date of the enactment
- 17 of this Act, and apply with respect to periods of eligibility
- 18 and entitlement beginning on or after such date.
- 19 (d) Application to Eligibility and Entitle-
- 20 MENT FOR WHICH TIME LIMITATION HAS EXPIRED.—(1)
- 21 In the case of an individual whose period for use of entitle-
- 22 ment to educational assistance under chapter 30 of title
- 23 38, United States Code, has expired by reason of section
- 24 3031 of such title before the date of the enactment of this
- 25 Act, the individual may use any unexpended portion of

- 1 such entitlement during the 5-year period that begins on
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 3 (2) The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall provide
- 4 for notice to individuals referred to in paragraph (1) of
- 5 the opportunity under this subsection to use any unex-
- 6 pended portion of entitlement to educational assistance
- 7 under such chapter 30 during such 5-year period.
