## A BILL

To suspend through December 31, 2005, the duty on certain textile machinery.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN TEXTILE MACHINERY.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7       new heading:

“	9902.84.11	Power weaving machines (looms), shuttle type, for weaving fabrics of a width exceeding 30 cm but not exceeding 4.9 m, entered without off-loom or large loom take-ups, dropwires, needles, reeds, harness frames, or beams (provided for in subheading 8446.21.50) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
 4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
