- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXISTING DUTY SUSPENSIONS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
- 5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
- 6 amended in the effective period column of headings
- 7 9902.28.08, 9902.28.09, and 9902.28.10 by striking the
- 8 date contained therein and inserting "12/31/2005".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 10 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,

- 1 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment
