A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain entries of protective cases.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. DUTY RELIQUIDATION FOR CERTAIN PROTEC-4 TIVE CASES ENTERED ON OR AFTER MARCH 5 3, 1999, AND BEFORE APRIL 19, 1999. 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 514 and 7 520 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514 and 1520) 8 or any other provision of law, not later than 90 days after the receipt of the request described in subsection (b), any

article that was entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for

- 1 consumption on or after March 3, 1999, and before April
- 2 19, 1999, and with respect to which subheading
- 3 9903.08.08 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
- 4 United States applied, shall be liquidated or reliquidated
- 5 as if subheading 4202.32.10 of the Harmonized Tariff
- 6 Schedule applied to such entry or withdrawal, and the Sec-
- 7 retary of the Treasury shall refund any excess duty paid
- 8 with respect to such entry.
- 9 (b) Requests.—Liquidation or reliquidation may be
- 10 made under subsection (a) with respect to any entry only
- 11 if a request therefor is filed with the Customs Service,
- 12 within 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act,
- 13 that contains sufficient information to enable the Customs
- 14 Service to locate the entry or to reconstruct the entry if
- 15 it cannot be located.
