A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on ortho-phenylphenol (OPP).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ORTHO-PHENYLPHENOL (OPP).**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by striking the date in the effective period col-
7 umn of heading 9902.29.25 and inserting “12/31/2005”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
