2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN SILVER PAINTS AND PASTES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.28.43	P6100-52% silver Ag Paint; P7400-52.8% silver Ag Paint; P7402-61.6% silver Ag Paste; and P7500-52.8% silver Ag Paint (provided for in subheading 2843.10.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
