## A BILL

To amend the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 to allow certain grant funds to be used to provide parent education.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PARENT EDUCATION SYSTEM.**

4       Section 30201(a)(2) of the Violent Crime Control and  
5       Law Enforcement Act of 1994 is amended by adding at  
6       the end the following:

7               “(O) Voluntary, comprehensive, and cul-  
8               turally-appropriate home visitor systems that

1 provide parenting education that focuses on  
2 parenting skills, child development, child health,  
3 and support services for new parents to prevent  
4 or decrease the risk of child abuse. To avoid du-  
5 plication of services, a system developed pursu-  
6 ant to this paragraph shall be coordinated with  
7 other organizations that provide services to chil-  
8 dren, particularly infants.”.
