## A BILL

To suspend until December 31, 2006, the duty on Benzenepropanal, 4-(1,1-Dimethylethyl)-Alpha-Methyl.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. BENZENEPROPANAL, 4-(1,1-DIMETHYLETHYL)-**  
4       **ALPHA-METHYL.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8       new heading:

“	9902.34.31	Benzenepropanal, 4-(1,1-Dimethylethyl)- Alpha-Methyl (CAS No. 80- 54-6) (provided for in subheading 2912.29.60) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2006	”.

1 (b) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514  
3 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision of  
4 law, upon proper written request filed with the Cus-  
5 toms Service not later than 120 days after the date  
6 of the enactment of this Act, any entry of an article  
7 described in heading 9902.34.31 of the Harmonized  
8 Tariff Schedule of the United States (as added by  
9 subsection (a)) that was made—

10 (A) after December 31, 2001, and

11 (B) before the date that is 15 days after  
12 the date of the enactment of this Act,  
13 shall be liquidated or reliquidated, as appropriate, as  
14 though such entry occurred after the date that is 15  
15 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.

16 (2) REQUIREMENTS FOR REQUEST.—For pur-  
17 poses of paragraph (1), the request shall contain  
18 sufficient information to enable the Customs Service  
19 to—

20 (A) locate the entry relevant to the re-  
21 quest; or

1 (B) if the entry cannot be located, recon-  
2 struct the entry.

3 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
4 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
6 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
