A BILL

To authorize State and local governments to regulate, for public safety purposes, trains that block road traffic.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Railroad Crossing
- 5 Delay Safety Assurance Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AUTHORITY.
- 7 If the Secretary of Transportation has not, before
- 8 August 1, 2002, issued regulations to address the problem
- 9 of trains blocking road traffic, a State or local government

- 1 may enact a law or regulation to address such problem
- 2 for the purpose of ensuring public safety.
