Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. 2-METHYL-4-CHLOROPHENOXYACETIC ACID.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.29.81 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended—

(1) by striking "2.6%" and inserting "Free"; and

(2) by striking "12/31/2003" and inserting

"12/31/2005".
