A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain polyamides.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN
4	POLYAMIDES.
5	(a) Finding and Purpose.—
6	(1) FINDING.—The Congress finds that
7	ORGASOL® micro-porous, ultrafine spherical poly-
8	amide powders are entitled to duty suspension under
9	the current subheading 9902.39.08 of the Har-
10	monized Tariff Schedule of the United States.
11	(2) Purpose.—The purpose of this Act is to

provide a technical correction thereto in order to

- 1 clarify the intent of Congress and to extend the duty
- 2 suspension for these products.
- 3 (b) In General.—Heading 9902.39.08 of the Har-
- 4 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
- 5 by striking "forms of polyamide-6, polyamide-12, and pol-
- 6 yamide-6,12 powders (CAS Nos. 25038–54–4, 25038–74–
- 7 8, and 25191–04–1) (provided for in subheading
- 8 3908.10.00)" and inserting "ORGASOL® polyamide
- 9 powders (provided for in subheading 3908.10.00 or
- 10 3908.90.70)".
- 11 (c) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 12 subsection (b) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 13 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 14 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
