3	SECTION 1. FLUOROBENZENE.
4	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7	new heading:
	" 9902.29.06   Fluorobenzene (CAS No. 462– 06–6) (provided for in subheading 2903.69.70)   Free   No change   No change   On or before 12/31/2006   ".

8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by

9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
