- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "The DNA Local Gov-
- 5 ernment Access Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO APPLY
- 7 FOR AND RECEIVE DNA BACKLOG ELIMI-
- 8 NATION GRANTS.
- 9 The DNA Analysis Backlog Elimination Act of 2000
- 10 (42 U.S.C. 14135) is amended—

1	(1) in subsection (a)—
2	(A) by inserting after "eligible States" the
3	following: "(or eligible units of local govern-
4	ment, as applicable)"; and
5	(B) by inserting "(or unit)" after "the
6	State" each place such term appears;
7	(2) in subsection (b), by inserting "(or unit)"
8	after "State"—
9	(A) in each place such term appears, ex-
10	cept in the case of paragraph (3); and
11	(B) in the first place such term appears, in
12	the case of paragraph (3);
13	(3) in subsections (c), (d), (e), (f), and (h), by
14	inserting "(or unit)" after "State" each place such
15	term appears; and
16	(4) in subsection (d)(2)(A), by inserting "(and
17	units)" after "States".
