A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Black Alc Powder.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. BLACK ALC POWDER.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.32.11	Black Ale Powder, A 2:1 mixture of; a) tris(3,5,5-trimethylhexylammonium) 4-amino-3-{4-[4-(4-amino-2-hydroxyphenylazo)anilino]-3-sulphonatophenylazo}-5,6-dihydro-5-oxo-6-phenylhydrazone-phthalene-2,7-disulphonate b) tris(3,5,5-trimethylhexylammonium) 4-amino-3-{4-[4-(2-amino-2-hydroxyphenylazo)anilino]-3-sulphonatophenylazo}-5,6-dihydro-5-oxo-6-phenylhydrazone-phthalene-2,7-disulphonate (provided for in subheading 3204.14.30)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2007	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to articles entered, or
 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
