To amend titles XI and XIX of the Social Security Act to provide American Samoa with treatment under the Medicaid Program similar to that provided to States.

- 3 SECTION 1. CHANGE IN MEDICAID PAYMENTS TO AMER-

- 5 (a) Payment of Regular Matching Rate.—Sec-
- 6 tion 1905(b)(2) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- 7 1396d(b)(2)) is amended by striking "the Northern Mar-
- 8 iana Islands, and American Samoa" and inserting "and
- 9 the Northern Mariana Islands".

1 (b) Increase in Payment Ceiling.—Section 1108 2 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1308) is amended— 3 (1) in subsection (f), by striking "subsection (g)" and inserting "subsections (g) and (h)"; and 5 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-6 section: 7 "(h) Medicaid Payments to American Samoa.— 8 Notwithstanding subsections (f) and (g), the total amount certified by the Secretary under title XIX with respect to 10 a fiscal year for payment to American Samoa shall not 11 exceed— 12 "(1) for fiscal year 2003 \$10,000,000; and 13 "(2) for each succeeding fiscal year the amount 14 provided in this subsection for the preceding fiscal 15 year increased by the percentage increase in the 16 medical care component of the consumer price index 17 for all urban consumers (as published by the Bureau 18 of Labor Statistics) for the twelve-month period end-19 ing in March preceding the beginning of the fiscal 20 year, rounded to the nearest \$10,000.". 21 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by 22 this section shall take effect as of October 1, 2002, and shall apply to fiscal years beginning on or after such date.
