A BILL

- To facilitate the ability of certain spectrum auction winners to pursue alternative measures required in the public interest to meet the needs of wireless telecommunications consumers.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. RETURN OF DOWNPAYMENTS.
 - 4 On or before the 15th day after the date of enactment
 - 5 of this Act, the Federal Communications Commission shall
 - 6 return to the winning bidders of auction 35 the full
 - 7 amount of all deposits and downpayments made by such

- 1 winning bidders for licenses that the Commission has not
- 2 by that date delivered to such winning bidders.

3 SEC. 2. RELIEF FROM CONTINUING OBLIGATIONS.

- 4 Each such winning bidder that elects, by formal writ-
- 5 ten notice to the Commission on or before the 15th day
- 6 after the date of enactment of this Act, to relinquish its
- 7 rights under auction 35 to receive a license for which it
- 8 was the winning bidder, and which the Commission has
- 9 not delivered to such bidder by the date of such election,
- 10 shall be free of all obligations such winning bidder would
- 11 otherwise have with respect to such license, including the
- 12 obligation to pay the full amount of its winning bid upon
- 13 delivery of such license.

14 SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.

- 15 For purposes of this Act:
- (1) COMMISSION.—The term "Commission"
 means the Federal Communications Commission.
- 18 (2) Auction 35.—The term "auction 35"
- means the Commission's C and F block broadband
- 20 personal communications service spectrum auction,
- which began on December 12, 2000, and ended on
- January 26, 2001, insofar as such auction related to
- spectrum previously licensed to NextWave Personal
- 24 Communications Inc., NextWave Power Partners,
- 25 Inc., or Urban Comm-North Carolina, Inc.

1 (3) Winning Bidder.—The term "winning 2 bidder" means those bidders whose applications for 3 auction 35 licenses the Commission accepted for fil-4 ing, as listed in Appendix A to the Commission's 5 Public Notice DA 01–520, issued on February 27, 6 2001.
