A BILL

To reinstate the license and extend commencement of construction deadlines for the Carlyle Hydroelectric Project in the State of Illinois, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT AND TRANSFER OF A SUR-
- 4 RENDERED LICENSE.
- 5 The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission shall,
- 6 upon the request of licensee for the FERC Project No.
- 7 11214, reinstate the license for the project effective as of
- 8 the effective date of the surrender thereof.

1 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.

- 2 Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of
- 3 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806), the Federal En-
- 4 ergy Regulatory Commission shall, upon the request of the
- 5 licensee for FERC Project No. 11214 (and after reason-
- 6 able notice) in accordance with the requirements of such
- 7 section 13 and the Commission's procedures under such
- 8 section, extend the time required for commencement of
- 9 construction for the project for up to a maximum of 3
- 10 consecutive 2-year periods commencing on the date of the
- 11 enactment of this Act.
