## A BILL

To reinstate the license and extend commencement of construction deadlines for the Carlyle Hydroelectric Project in the State of Illinois, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT AND TRANSFER OF A SUR-**  
4       **RENDERED LICENSE.**

5       The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission shall,  
6       upon the request of licensee for the FERC Project No.  
7       11214, reinstate the license for the project effective as of  
8       the effective date of the surrender thereof.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

2       Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of  
3 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806), the Federal En-  
4 ergy Regulatory Commission shall, upon the request of the  
5 licensee for FERC Project No. 11214 (and after reason-  
6 able notice) in accordance with the requirements of such  
7 section 13 and the Commission's procedures under such  
8 section, extend the time required for commencement of  
9 construction for the project for up to a maximum of 3  
10 consecutive 2-year periods commencing on the date of the  
11 enactment of this Act.
