A BILL

To reauthorize funding for the Water Desalination Act of
1996, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION.**

4 Section 8 of the Water Desalination Act of 1996 (110
5 Stat. 3622, 3624; P.L. 104–298; 42 U.S.C. 10301 note)
6 is amended to read as follows:

1 **“SEC. 8. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 “(a) SECTION 3.—There are authorized to be appro-
3 priated to carry out section 3 of this Act \$5,000,000 per
4 year for fiscal years 2003–2008. Of these amounts, up to
5 \$1,000,000 in each fiscal year may be awarded to institu-
6 tions of higher education, including United States-Mexico
7 binational research foundations and interuniversity re-
8 search programs established by the two countries, for re-
9 search grants without any cost-sharing requirement.

10 “(b) SECTION 4.—There are authorized to be appro-
11 priated to carry out section 4 of this Act \$25,000,000 for
12 fiscal years 2003 through 2008.”.
