## **AN ACT**

- To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire the property in Cecil County, Maryland, known as Garrett Island for inclusion in the Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge.

  - **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Blackwater National5 Wildlife Refuge Expansion Act".

1 (c) PURPOSES.—The purposes for which the Garrett 2 Island Unit is established and shall be managed are the 3 following: 4 (1) To support the Delmarva Conservation Cor-5 ridor Demonstration Program. 6 (2) To conserve, restore, and manage habitats 7 as necessary to contribute to the migratory bird pop-8 ulations prevalent in the Atlantic Flyway. 9 (3) To conserve, restore, and manage the sig-10 nificant aquatic resource values associated with sub-11 merged land adjacent to the unit and to achieve the 12 habitat objectives of the agreement known as the 13 Chesapeake 2000 Agreement. 14 (4) To conserve the archaeological resources on 15 the unit. 16 (5) To provide public access to the unit in a 17 manner that does not adversely impact natural re-18 sources on and around the unit. 19 SEC. 4. ACCOKEEK CREEK NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE. 20 ESTABLISHMENT.—There is (a)established the21 Accokeek Creek National Wildlife Refuge in Stafford Coun-22 ty, Virginia, consisting of approximately 7,480 acres lo-23 cated between Accokeek Creek to the north and Potomac 24 Creek to the south as depicted on Map 2 entitled "Proposed Accokeek Creek National Wildlife Refuge" contained in the
 Final Environmental Assessment dated October, 2000.

3 (b) ACQUISITION AND ADMINISTRATION.—The Sec-4 retary of the Interior is authorized to acquire from willing 5 parties by purchase, lease, exchange, and donation land 6 within the boundary depicted on the map referenced in sub-7 section (a), which shall be administered by the Secretary 8 in accordance with the laws (including regulations) relat-9 ing to the National Wildlife Refuge System.
